1. REPORT ON THE 38TH ORDINARY SESSION OF THE HEADS OF STATE AND GOVERNMENT OF THE AFRICAN UNION

1.1 Cabinet took note of the Report and directed all Offices/Ministries/Agencies (O/M/As) and relevant stakeholders to consider streamlining and aligning their activities/programmes for the year, including the Africa Day, Genocide Remembrance Day and the Human Rights Day to incorporate the Theme of the Year (*“Justice for Africans and People of African Descent Through Reparations”*); and to seize opportunities presented by a complex and competitive global environment and make this a top priority; and

1.2 Cabinet further directed the Ministries of International Relations and Trade; Justice and Labour Relations; and Gender Equality and Child Welfare to take action in their areas of responsibility.

2. TOTAL ALLOWABLE CATCH (TAC) FOR MONK FOR THE 2025/2026 FISHING SEASON, 1st MAY 2025 to 30th APRIL 2026

Cabinet approved the Total Allowable Catch (TAC) for Monk to be set at nine-thousand, six-hundred (9,600) Metric Tonnes (MT) for the 2025/2026 Fishing Season.
