1. FEEDBACK REPORT ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF CABINET DECISIONS FOR THE PERIOD 1st APRIL 2024- 30th SEPTEMBER 2024

Cabinet took note of the Feedback Report on the Implementation of Cabinet Decisions for the period 1st April 2024 – 30th September 2024 and directed Offices/Ministries/Agencies (O/M/As) to expedite the finalisation of the outstanding decisions, and to continuously provide feedback on the progress made until full implementation is achieved.

Cabinet directed the Ministry of International Relations and Trade, in collaboration with O/M/As to prioritise the development and implementation of an online Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) tracking system, as part of the commitment to improve diplomatic engagements. The centralised database of all MoUs will facilitate seamless tracking of the status of Agreements and ensure that, Namibia maximize benefits accruing from the respective Agreements.

Cabinet directed Offices/Ministries/Agencies to prioritise the filling of critical positions, in order to accelerate the implementation of Cabinet Decisions.

2. IMPLEMENTATION, MONITORING, EVALUATION PLAN (IMEP) OF THE SIXTH NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN (NDP6)

Cabinet approved, in principle, the Implementation, Monitoring and Evaluation Plan (IMEP) of the 6th National Development Plan (NDP6) and directed all Offices/Ministries/Agencies (O/M/As) to provide accurate baseline information for NDP6 targets, and integrate the Performance Review on NDP6 in the Performance Management System (PMS).

Cabinet further directed the National Planning Commission to host an NDP6 IMEP validation Workshop for Cabinet Members to review all NDP6 Desirable Outcomes.

3. RATIFICATION OF THE PROTOCOL AMENDING THE MARRAKESH AGREEMENT ESTABLISHING THE WORLD TRADE ORGANISATION (WTO) AGREEMENT ON FISHERIES SUBSIDIES

Cabinet approved that Namibia ratify the Protocol amending the Marrakesh Agreement establishing the World Trade Organisation (WTO) Agreement on Fisheries Subsidies (AFS).

Cabinet authorised the Minister of International Relations and Trade to deposit the instrument of acceptance with the WTO.

Cabinet approved, in principle, for the Ministry of International Relations and Trade to finalise Namibia's ratification of the Agreement on Fisheries Subsidies (AFS) in Parliament.

4. THE 4th EDITION OF THE SOUTHERN AFRICAN DEVELOPMENT COMMUNITY (SADC) CORRECTIONS/ PRISONS/PENITENTIARY SERVICES SPORTS AND CULTURAL GAMES IN WINDHOEK, NAMIBIA FROM 4-8 AUGUST 2025

Cabinet approved for the Ministry of Home Affairs, Immigration, Safety and Security to host the Fourth (4th) Edition of the Southern African Development Community (SADC) Corrections/Prisons/Penitentiary Sports and Cultural Games 2025, in Windhoek, Namibia from 4 to 8 August 2025.
